National Forum Heart Healthy Stroke Free Awards

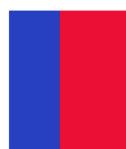
Presented to an individual and a group whose work embodies the recommendations of *A Public Health Action Plan to Prevent Heart Disease and Stroke*.
